2. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance. Alderman Trent Thomas led the Council in the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Consider and Take Action City Co-Sponsorship of July 4th Parade.

Other parade participants would be the President of the POA, the President of the MUD, a representative from the Club, Fire Department vehicles, Precinct 3 Constable Car, a bag piper and drummer, the Boy Scouts and residents in golf carts.
- Mayor Zdunkewicz suggested having a “kick off” event with a podium with a brief welcome and introduction of local dignitaries followed immediately by the parade.
- Alderman Cliff Aldrich said it would be nice to invite Liz Taylor of the US Coast Guard to sing the National Anthem.
- The city would sponsor the bag piper.
- Kathy Nida will prepare a patriotic flyer with information.
- A formal co-sponsorship by the POA and MUD had not been confirmed, but they would be invited to participate.

Alderman Gary Owens made a motion to move forward as outlined in the write-up as presented by Alderman Cliff Aldrich and give the mayor the authority to invite and recognize local dignitaries; also approving up to \$350 to pay for the bag piper; it was seconded by Alderman Denis DeLuca.
