

Mayors Comments

In the August 25th Regular City Council Meeting, the Council voted to approve the 2010 Fiscal Year Budget.

After I discussed the mowing schedule with TX DOT, Alderman DeLuca surveyed the City's portion of adopted highway on FM 1093 and deemed it unsafe for city volunteers to pick up trash along the highway. A combination of tall grass/weeds, challenging terrain and the possibility of not being able to see critters in the tall grass have led to the decision to postpone the clean up scheduled for September 26th. Once a firm mow date is in hand we will schedule the next Adopt-A-Highway date and contact you with the details. We appreciate your support and know you understand and share our priorities. Volunteers are still needed for the next trash pickup.

The City of Weston Lakes has cancelled the November 3rd Election because all candidates are running unopposed.

On September 8th, the City held their first Emergency Preparedness Exercise at the Weston Lakes Country Club. Presentations were given by Deputy Fire Chief Marshal of Harris County Bob Royall, Fire Marshal Trainer Tom Linnenkugel, Lt. Commander Joe Leonard of the United States Coast Guard, and Dr. Neil Frank . Our Emergency Incident Commander, Cliff Aldrich presented a mock scenario of an emergency and participants discussed solutions and actions. Thanks to all who participated and special thanks to Alderman Aldrich for his efforts in coordinating the evening's events.

With a little help from Mother Nature and resident conservation, MUD81 has informed the Mayor's office that we are no longer in drought conditions. We appreciate all of the residents that have participated in the conservation of our water resources.
