The Ft Bend Co. Sheriff's Office is located in one of the most diverse and fastest growing counties in the nation. Out of an approximate population of 498,000 the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office provides service to approximately 249,000. The Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office was established in 1838 and currently employs 564 full time employees and approximately 40 reserve deputies. The Sheriff's Office is a large facility containing 14 divisions including the county jail that is currently in the process of expanding to a larger capacity and as of now holds a 760-inmate capacity. The Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office offers services in all facets of a law enforcement agency: Public Safety, Enforcement of law, Detention, Investigation, Identification, Public Information, Communications for Police, Fire and Medical, Victim Services, Law Enforcement Training Academy, Court House Security, and Ft. Bend Co. Alumni Citizens Association.

The Sheriff's Office has existing collaboration with the Fort Bend County District Attorney's Office, 4 Precinct Constable Offices, 8 Municipal Police Departments, The Texas Department of Public Safety, The Texas Rangers, 11 Emergency Medical Services, 12 Fire departments and the Texas Vine project. The Sheriff's Office promotes victim rights and services through Public Relations, Media, Community Events and Public Presentations.
